## 1. MRS STEWART'S JIG

Frans Ligtmans: RSCDS XXXV
1-8 1s set, 1 L followed by partner casts 2 places, 1 L crosses (below 3s) \& casts up on Men's side to 2 nd place facing down while 1 M dances round 3 L \& up the middle to 2 nd place Ladies side facing down
9-16 $2 s+1 s+3 s$ dance Grand Chain, end with $2 M$ \& 1 M facing out
17-24 2s+1s dance Ladies Chain
25-32 $2 \mathrm{~s}+1 \mathrm{~s}+3 \mathrm{~s}$ Adv+Ret for 2 steps \& 1s turn 1.1/2 RH to own sides

## 2. THE HIGHLAND RAMBLER $3 / 4 L \cdot R 40$

Roy Goldring (1985): Thirty Popular Dances, Volume Two
1-8: 1 s dance in \& cast to 2nd place, dance RH across with 3s
9-16: $2 s+1$ s dance LH across, 1 L followed by partner cast up round 2 L \& dance down middle to 1 L between $3 \mathrm{~s} \& 1 \mathrm{M}$ between 2 s
17-24: $1 \mathrm{~s}+2 \mathrm{~s}+3 \mathrm{~s}$ dance down the middle \& back
25-32: 1 M followed by partner dance up, cast down round 2 L to 2 nd places on own side \& turn RH
26-40: $2 \mathrm{~s}+1 \mathrm{~s}+3 \mathrm{~s}$ circle 6 H round and back

## 3. THE GENTLEMAN <br> $3 / 4 \mathrm{~L} \cdot \mathrm{~S} 32$

Roz Scott Huxley (1986): Book 35 Scottish Country Dances
1-8 1s turn 2H \& remain in middle facing each other as 2s step up, 1s+2s set (1s advancing \& pass LSh to face opposite partner) \& dance $1 / 2$ reel of 4 across with 2s; 1s ending reel giving LH to face down on own side between 2 s (nearer hands joined)
9-16 1 s dance down to end between 3 s \& face each other, $1 \mathrm{~s}+3 \mathrm{~s}$ set (1s advancing \& pass LSh to face opposite partner) \& $1 / 2$ reel of 4 across with 3 s ; 1 s end giving LH to face up on own side between 3s
17-24 1s lead up to top, cross over \& cast to 2 nd place \& $1 / 2$ reels of 3 across ( $L$ with $2 \mathrm{~s} \& \mathrm{M}$ with 3 s )
25-32 2s+1s dance Diamond Poussette

## 4. A CAPITAL JIG 3/4L • J32

Tine E MacKay: Magazine Dances 2005-2009
1-8 $1 \mathrm{~s}+2 \mathrm{~s}$ Set \& Rotate \& end 1 s facing up, 2s down:Set, rotate singly \& dance on 1 place clockwise, change places RH on sides \& dance on 1 place to own sides (1s in 2nd place facing up)
9-16 1 s dance reels of 3 on own sides (RSh to 2 s )
17-24 1s set \& turn 3/4 RH to face own sides, 1s dance LH across ( 1 L with 2 s , 1 M with 3 s ) to end 2nd place opposite sides
25-32 1s set \& turn 3/4 RH to face opposite sides, 1 s dance LH across ( 1 M with 2 s , 1 L with 3 s ) ending 2 nd place own sides

## 5. THE BRAES OF TULLIEMET 3/4L • S32

RSCDS VII
1-8 1 s set \& cast 1 place, cross RH \& cast down 1 place on opposite sides
9-16 $3 s+1 \mathrm{~s}$ dance 4 H round to left, 1 s lead up to top \& cast on opposite sides to face 1 st corners
17-24 1 s set \& turn 1st corner, set \& turn 2nd corner
25-32 1s dance reels of 3 on opposite sides giving LSh to 1st corners \& cross RH to 2nd place on own sides

## 6. POLHARROW BURN <br> 5/5L • R32

Hugh Foss (1967): Magazine Dances 2005-2009
1-8 $1 \mathrm{~s} \& 3 \mathrm{~s}$ cross RH, cast 1 place \& dance $1 / 2$ Fig of 8 round couple above them
9-16 1s \& 3s turn RH then LH (long turns) to face 1st corners while 2 s \& $5 \mathrm{~s} 1 / 2$ turn RH \& chase clockwise to other end of set
17-24 1s \& 3s dance 1/2 Reels of 4 with 1st corners then 2nd corners
25-32 1s \& 3s dance 1/2 Reel of 4 with 3rd corner, turn partner LH \& cast down 1 place own sides. 2 4153

## 7. THE ROSELATH CROSS 3/4L • J32

Henrietta Vosper (1998): Book XLI
1-8 $1 \mathrm{~s}+2 \mathrm{~s}+3 \mathrm{~s}$ dance reflection reels of 3 on sides ( 1 s dance in \& down to start) \& end with 1 s in 2nd pl BtoB facing own sides \& 2 s in 1 st pl
9-16 $2 s+1 s+3 s$ set, $1 \mathrm{~s} 1 / 4$ turn to right \& set with $2 s+3 s$ (as Crown Triangles), 1 s dance RSh round RH crnr into middle BtoB facing opp sides
17-24 Repeat from new positions 1s ending in 2nd place own sides
25-32 1s dance reels of 3 across (Lady with $2 \mathrm{~s} \&$ Man with 3s)

## 8. CATCH THE WIND 3/4L•R32

Romaine Butterfield (1983): RSCDS XLV
1-8 1 s set, cast 1 place \& dance $1 / 2$ Fig of 8 round 2 s
9-16 1 s set twice with 1 L turning to face out, 1 L followed by partner casts up \& dances down the middle 1 L to face 3 M while 1 M faces 2 M

17-24 1s RSh reels of 3 across (1M with 2s \& 1L with 3s)
25-32 1L followed by partner dances down cast up round 3 M \& crosses to end in 2nd place on own sides, 1s turn RH (4 bars)

## 9. SANDY BUTTERLY <br> 4/4L •J48

Mary Shoolbraid Brandon: Let's All Dance Too
1-8 1 s lead down to bottom \& cast up on own sides back to place
9-16 4s cast up behind own sides to top \& lead down to places
17-24 $2 \mathrm{~s}+3 \mathrm{~s}$ circle 4 H round \& back
25-32 1s \& 4s turn RH (4 bars), turn LH (4 bars)
33-40 2s \& 3s dance Figs of 8 round end couples
41-48 1s cross RH, cast 1 place, cross LH \& cast to bottom

## 10. LINNEA'S STRATHSPEY 3/4L•S32

Tim Wilson (2001): RSCDS Book 47
1-8 1s set \& cast 1 place, 1s cross passing LSh \& cast RSh round 1st corners into face them
9-16 1s dance 'Hello-Goodbye' setting \& end passing RSh to face out in 2nd place own sides
17-24 2 s \& $3 \mathrm{~s} 3 / 4$ turn RH into middle while 1 s cast to right picking up 2L/3M and promenade $1 / 2$ way clockwise as $2 \mathrm{M}+3 \mathrm{~L}$ turn LH 1.1/2 times, 1s dance on to 2 nd place own sides while 3 s \& 2s $3 / 4$ turn RH. All 3 couples finish in middle facing up 312
25-32 $3 s+1 s+2 s$ dance Allemande

## 11. THE EDINBURGH TOY SHOP 3/4L•J32

Ethan Bailey: RSCDS LI
1-8 1 s set, dance down \& cast up round 3 s (2s step up 3-4), $2 \mathrm{~s}+1 \mathrm{~s}+3 \mathrm{~s}$ set
9-16 $1 / 2$ Fig 8 ( 1 L round 2 M , 1 M round 3 L ) to 2 nd place opp sides, $2 \mathrm{~s}+1 \mathrm{~s}+3 \mathrm{~s}$ set \& 1 s turn LH to face 1st corners
17-24 1s turn 1st corner RH, pass partner RSh, turn 2nd corner RH, pass partner RSh to 2nd place own sides
25-32 $2 \mathrm{~s}+1 \mathrm{~s}+3 \mathrm{~s}$ circle 6 H round \& back

## 12. FLOWERS OF EDINBURGH

 3/4L•R32RSCDS I
1-8 $\quad 1 \mathrm{~L}$ followed by partner casts below $3 \mathrm{~s}, 1 \mathrm{~L}$ crosses \& dances up behind Men as 1 M dances up
centre to 1 st places on opposite side \& 1 s set
9-16 1 M followed by partner repeat above Fig \& set in own places
17-24 1s lead down the middle \& back
25-32 1s+2s dance Poussette 213
